Terms of PDE2D Software License

- 1 **License Grant and Title:** Licensee is granted a nonexclusive right to install PDE2D on one computer system (one at a time), for each license purchased. Licensee agrees to take reasonable steps to ensure that no portion of the PDE2D source or binary code (except the interactive driver or GUI) is transferred to any other computer system, or in any manner made available to unauthorized persons. Licensee may not remove the IMSL Copyright notices from the IMSL subroutines included within the PDE2D source. Copyright, title and interest to PDE2D remain with Granville Sewell and with Rogue Wave, Inc.
- 2 **License Term:** The license term is for one year, and begins 7 days after shipment. Unless terminated as provided in Sections 4 or 5, each license will automatically renew each year, at the price in effect at the end of the initial or subsequent term.
- 3 **Payment:** License fees are payable in U.S.Dollars, and are due at the beginning of each license term. Fees not paid within 90 days of the due date are considered delinquent.
- 4 **Termination by Licensee:** Licensee may terminate this agreement without cause by giving written notice within 30 days of the beginning of the second and subsequent license terms. A renewal notice will be sent to licensee before the beginning of each renewal term, and the desire to terminate can be indicated on this form. Licensee may also terminate this agreement within 30 days of the beginning of the initial term, if he is unsuccessful in installing PDE2D on the computer for which it has been leased.
- 5 **Termination by Vendor:** Granville Sewell may terminate this agreement if license fees are delinquent, or if licensee otherwise violates the terms of the agreement. If the agreement is terminated by either party, all copies of the PDE2D source and binary code (except the interactive driver) in licensee's power shall be destroyed.
- 6 **Maintenance:** Granville Sewell agrees to take reasonable measures to correct errors in PDE2D, and to make these corrections available to licensees in a timely manner. Licensees will also receive, at no cost, any new editions released during the license term.
- 7 **Consulting:** Granville Sewell agrees to assist authorized users, at their request, in preparing their PDE2D input programs, to the extent that he is able to do so. This consulting obligation may be limited to 10 free hours per license per year.
