## Master of Arts in Teaching Mathematics

- ⌘ A Master's Degree specific to teaching mathematics
- ⌘ A part-time program for teachers
- ⌘ Evening classes
- ⌘ Two options: 36 hours of coursework , or 24 hours of coursework plus 6 thesis hours.
- ⌘ Two courses per semester
- ⌘ Courses include Technology in the Mathematics Classroom, Geometry and Calculus, and Introduction to Research

Many school districts subsidize costs of this program – check with yours. By participating in UTEP's SABEMAS (a Learning Academy Program that focuses on STEM content knowledge and pedagogy), you will receive financial assistance for tuition and books as well as a stipend!
